You should contact your <u>Primary Care Physician</u> and/or go to Urgent Care Facility for treatment • Accidents and Falls • Moderate Sprains • Moderate Backaches • Mild Breathing Difficulty (i.e. Asthma) • Minor Cuts with Controlled Bleeding • Eye Irritation/Redness • Cold/Flu Symptoms WITH fever • Vomiting/Diarrhea with Dehydration • Severe Sore Throat or Cough • Minor Broken Bones or Fractures (fingers/toes) • Skin Rashes and Infections • Urinary Tract Infections • Minor Injuries • Minor Burns	You should go to your nearest Hospital Emergency Department • Severe Chest Pain or Difficulty Breathing • Compound Fracture (bone protrudes through skin) • Convulsions/Seizures • Loss of Consciousness • Fever in Newborn (less than 3 months old) • Heavy, Uncontrollable Bleeding • Deep Knife or Gunshot Wounds • Moderate to Severe Burns • Poisoning • Serious Head/Neck or Back Injury • Pregnancy-Related Problems • Severe Abdominal Pain • Signs of Heart Attack (chest pain lasting longer than 2 minutes) • Signs of Stroke (loss of vision, sudden numbness, weakness, slurred speech or confusion) • Suicidal or Homicidal Thoughts/Feelings • Vomiting up Blood

When in doubt, patients who feel their symptoms require immediate medical attention may choose to go to a hospital emergency department, where medical professionals can determine which level of care is required.
